### PRESS BRIEFINGS

→ **TUESDAY:** The Thai National Shippers' Council holds its monthly meeting from 10.30am until noon. Officials plan to announce the export figures for March 2022 at the briefing held on Google Meet (<https://meet.google.com/kqn-qnty-dyb>).
